The completed forms and all other required materials must be received by the JSEHS Selection Committee, Center for Precollegiate Education and Training, PO Box 112010, Yon Hall Room 334, Gainesville, FL 32611-2010 by 5:00 PM Friday, November 20, 2009.

The Selection Committee will meet in December to review the materials of nominated students. Approximately 25 students will be selected. All candidates will be notified of the Selection Committee's decisions by December 16, 2009.

In the event that you are not selected to be a presenter, you are still welcome and encouraged to attend the JSEHS. You must be accompanied by an adult chaperone. If you have any questions please contact me at the CPET office.
