Program Overview



UF research faculty engage participants in university-level research as part of their lab team for ~30 hours/ week. UF SSTP offers a variety of research experiences within many STEM fields.



All participants attend an interdisciplinary lecture series presented by a variety of UF research faculty, and a UF Interdisciplinary Honors Seminar Course with their choice of topic.



Participants from a Florida high school may earn up to 6 credits of Dual Enrollment for their laboratory experience and Honors Seminar course.



Students live in UF residence halls along with counselors who facilitate campus living through community building and help participants adjust to living away from home.



Weekend events include field trips, social and service activities. Participants attend all UF SSTP sponsored social and weekend activities together.
